How To Get To Langkawi



By Flight

Hopping on a flight to Langkawi is the easiest and fastest way to get there. Just book a flight directly to Langkawi International Airport, located at the southwestern part of the island. You can hop on a private transfer or book a taxi/e-hailing service upon arrival.

Travel Duration:

- Kuala Lumpur <-> Langkawi: 1 hr ±
- Singapore <-> Langkawi: 1 hr 25 mins. ±
- Penang <-> Langkawi: 35 mins. ±



By Ferry

An alternative would be for you to drive up to Kuala Kedah or Kuala Perlis for a ferry ride to the island. The journey from these locations to Langkawi typically takes about 1 hour depending on sea conditions.

Travel Duration:

- Kuala Perlis <-> Langkawi Kuah: 1 hr 15 mins. ±
- Kuala Kedah <-> Langkawi Kuah: 1 hr 45 mins. ±
- Satun / Koh Lipe, Thailand <-> Kuah: 1 hr 15 mins. ±



By RO-RO Ferry

If you enjoy travelling in your own personal vehicle, the process is completely hassle-free. Online booking must be made 3 days before the date of travel with full payment. RORO ferry provides service transporting wheeled vehicles and passengers. Make sure you are well prepared with all the necessary documents before heading to the entry point at Kuala Perlis Terminal.

Getting Around Langkawi



Taxis Getting a taxi is a convenient way to get around, taxis operate on a fixed rate depending on the distance.

If travelling as a group, booking a Langkawi Taxi Van with an experienced English / Arabic speaking driver is certainly your first choice.

Car Rental The most convenient and cost-effective way of getting around Langkawi is to rent a car. Being a small island, a typical drive from end-to-end will usually take 30 minutes. In Malaysia they drive on the left hand side. Remember to always bring your driving license, valid credit card and additional proof of identity (such as a passport if you are hiring abroad).

E-hailing Apps Fret not if you prefer to rely on the all-too-familiar e-hailing app. Grab and MyCar are the two most popular apps in Langkawi although other e-hailing companies are already making headway in this popular tourist destination.

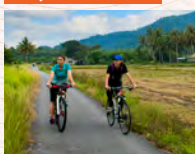
Motorbikes & Scooters Not only are motorbikes and scooters cheaper than renting a car, they're fun, convenient, and a common way to get around. They're so common that they are not strict on the license front although wearing a helmet is a requirement.

EV Electric Buses

The new EV electric bus service will commence in Langkawi starting September 2023. MARA Liner is currently operating a trial run (Bus No.: ML 022) for the Kuah to Padang Matsirat routes, more route will be introduced soon.



Bicycle Rentals



Although most motorbike and scooter rental outlets have bicycles for rent, you can actually book them ahead of time via online sites like Bikago, Klook, Veltra, or Book2wheel. Peddling across the beautiful landscape on an e-bike is another exciting option!

1. DON'T LITTER! – especially plastic bags and bottles.
2. Don't alter, destroy or move plants, nests, shells, limestone or corals.
3. Don't disturb animals (or other nature lovers).
4. Don't feed the animals as their diets are highly specialised.
5. Don't try to pet animals (especially monkeys!).
6. Don't buy ANY seashells or coral products, as this only encourages unsustainable practices.

Weather

Langkawi's daily weather is mostly sunny with temperatures varying between 30°C - 35°C, and between 28°C to 29°C at night. With accommodating climate all year round, you can plan your beach vacation any time you like.

Language

Malay is the national language of Malaysia, used in official ceremonies and documents. English is the second official language of the country, and most Malaysians can speak English fluently. Other major languages spoken are Chinese and Tamil.

Culture

The majority of the island's population is Muslim, as such please keep your attire modest especially when visiting traditional / religious attractions. Please refrain from wearing revealing clothes unless you're at the beach.

Travel Adapter

Malaysia uses the G plug type, which has three rectangular pins arranged in a triangular pattern and operates on a 240V supply voltage and 50Hz frequency.

Mobile Pack

The best and cheapest way is to get a prepaid SIM card. Service and sales counters can be found at the arrival hall of the Airport and jetty as well as convenient stores.

Money Changer & ATM

Money changers and ATMs are located at the airport and jetty, Kuah town, Pantai Chenang and most shopping malls.

8 Unique Dishes

That You Must Try in Langkawi

Whether you're a foodie or not, your trip to Langkawi would be incomplete without sampling the wide variety of Langkawi's tantalising cuisine. During your stay, however long it might be, don't miss your opportunity to savour delicious eats from around the island. With both budget friendly options and fine dining feasts available, you'll be spoiled for choice in popular tourists' areas such as Pantai Chenang and Pantai Tengah as well as the more luxe world class hotels. Both will leave your palate with a taste of a truly awe-inspiring travel destination.



1 Gulai Panas

Gulai Panas is a spicy and hot curry. If you love spicy food, make sure you don't miss this wholesome traditional Malay cuisine. Unlike thick and rich traditional curries, Gulai is more tangy and watery. Served hot, it's delicious when drenched over rice and best eaten with Sambal Belacan (Spicy Shrimp Paste) and Ulam-Ulaman (Traditional Vegetable Salad). You'll definitely be back for more.

3 Sup Gamat

Gamat is Langkawi's Ginseng of the Sea! This sea cucumber soup is one of the most unique Langkawi delicacies, boasting with healing properties and an irresistible taste! With diced sea cucumbers boiled with a host of herbs, the soup has long been used as traditional medicine by the locals.



2 Laksa

An explosion of taste, this spicy rice noodle dish is not-to-be-missed when you're in Langkawi. Its appetising and pungent broth is made with mackerel and aromatic herbs. There are many variations of laksa in Malaysia, and the key ingredient of Langkawi laksa is tamarind which gives the soup a distinctive tangy taste. It's topped with half a hard-boiled egg, garnished with thinly sliced cucumber, lettuce, pineapple, onion, mint leaves and chillies.

4 Laktud

Boasting with medicinal benefits, Laktud is a form of seaweed that grows a fair distance from the shore. As it's seasonal you can't always get it during off seasons. It is said to reduce your cholesterol, provide overall well-being with its wound-healing properties and much, much more.



5 Bronok

A unique, delicious, and addictive salad often eaten raw, the Bronok (Sea Cucumber) is sliced and then mixed with coconut condiments, sambal, chilli, kerisik, lengkuas, and shredded cashew leaves. This signature appetiser tastes salty, chewy and crunchy at the same time, it is a must-try dish that can only be found in Langkawi.



7 Mee Ketam (Crab Noodles)

It is one of the most popular dishes in Langkawi. Scrumptious gravy simmered with crab shells for hours gives you a classic essence of the sea. The yellow noodle is topped with fresh flower crabs and served in sweet potato-based gravy along with a generous squeeze of lime juice. Letting the succulent flower crab meat melt in your mouth can be incredibly rewarding, you'll certainly be yearning for another plate! Although Mee Udang (Prawn Noodles) is more popular in Malaysia, however Mee Ketam is far tastier!



6 Seafood

Langkawi is a uniquely seafood-centric island, blessed with an abundance of rich fishing grounds, seafood lovers can expect to find a vast array of fresh catch selections around the island at moderate prices. Grilled seafood is one of the most popular local dishes worth travelling for! With fresh seafood wrapped in banana leaves, marinated with a spice-laden sambal and grilled over a charcoal fire, your mouth will explode with irresistible smoky flavour and juicy tenderness.



8 Traditional Desserts: Bunga Puduk & Kuih Karas

Bunga Puduk and Kuih Karas are famous traditional desserts in Langkawi. Both desserts are flour based and are typically eaten during tea time as it goes perfectly with a cup of hot tea.

LWI Blue mineral water is bottled at our very own water centre in Langkawi UNESCO Global Geopark nestled at the base of Mount Raya and surrounded by protected rainforests. Sourced from 130 metres below the land of our own 130 acre water centre nestled amongst the prehistoric tropical rainforest at the base of Mount Raya, our natural mineral water is filtered through granite that is more than 200 million years old, ensuring it is pure and free from groundwater contamination. LWI BLUE mineral water has numerous healthy minerals including calcium, potassium, magnesium, sulphate and chloride.



Bronok and Gamat may look exotic, but they have a myriad of health benefits used in many traditional remedies making them a local island delicacy. Bronok is a unique food source that keeps the connection between the locals and their surrounding ecosystem strong. Gamat can be consumed or simply applied externally as an antibacterial disinfectant and is also anti-inflammatory. With the various benefits that Bronok and Gamat provide, it’s no wonder why these sea creatures have become synonymous with Langkawi.



6 Laktud & Mee Ketam

The list of food delicacies found in Langkawi keeps growing as local foodies and chefs venture into new flavours and ingredients. Perhaps one of the more recent food discoveries over the past decade is Laktud; a type of seaweed from a species of green algae found mainly in the Indo-Pacific region. Laktud is normally eaten raw or served as a salad. Here in Langkawi you can find Laktud prepared with a certain signature flair at Crab Farm Langkawi. They have the freshest Laktud because they grow them on site! As the name suggests, Crab Farm Langkawi grows Giant Mud Crabs and supplies them around the island to small eateries and with fresh ingredients around visitors can enjoy a delectable combination of Laktud Salad and Crab Noodles..



4 Virgin Coconut Oil

There have been over a thousand studies that have proven coconut oil to be one of the healthiest foods. The many uses and healing benefits of coconut oil go beyond people’s expectations as coconuts are indeed a true superfood. Here in Langkawi amidst the natural surroundings and serenity of Datai Valley, a very enterprising businesswoman has been spreading the health benefits of virgin coconut oil in maintaining overall vitality. This product is a great example of using the natural gifts provided by the environment, to maintain a sustainable business practice for the island.



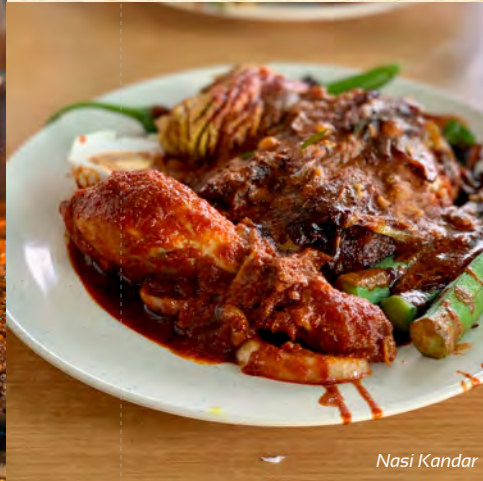
5 Madu Kelulut (Stingless Bee Honey)

Kelulut Honey (Madu in Malay) comes from a large tribe of bees called Meliponini, and are closely related to the Honey Bee, Carpenter Bee and Bumblebee.. The key difference that sets these Kelulut Bees apart, are their non-functioning stingers for defence (hence also commonly known as ‘stingless bees’). The honey produced from these stingless bees are nutrient rich and extremely high in antibacterial resistance compared to normal honey. This is because the bees collect nectar from the deepest part of the flower, where it has a richer concentration of plant nutrients. Here in Langkawi, the abundance of flora for nectar sources means that there’s a thriving stingless bee population that offers opportunity for harvesting Kelulut honey using sustainable beekeeping practices.

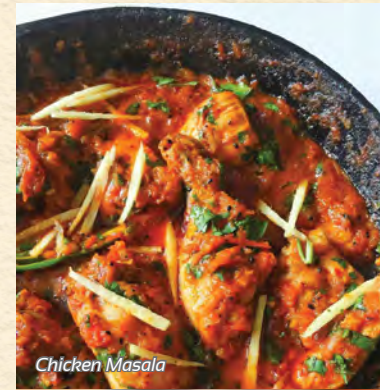
